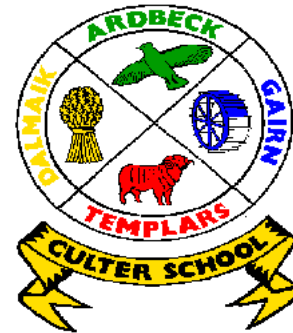


Culter School Newsletter
